
Field Studies Council is an environmental education charity. Founded in 1943, we are best known for providing residential and day field trips for those studying biology and geography at school and university.


Institute of Corrosion

The global cost of corrosion (the rusting of steel and corrosion of other metals), is estimated at £2.2. trillion per annum, or the equivalent of 3.4% of global GDP. It is estimated that between £300 and £700 billion of this can be saved using existing best practices, and many companies are actively engaged in the prevention of corrosion via corrosion engineering or corrosion management.

Like many industrial disciplines, this part of the industry has suffered dwindling numbers, leaving opportunities and jobs available for interested young people.

The Institute of Corrosion is the UK's primary body for preventing corrosion and offers a variety of training courses, research and events.

The significant number of companies involved in this field offer a variety of of routes into the industry. Companies include paint suppliers, facility operators, structural steel fabricators, and maintenance and inspection companies.









NHS Wellbeing in Mind

Education Mental Health Practitioners (EMHPs) provide early intervention for mental health difficulties, such as anxiety, depression, and behavioural problems. We offer low-intensity interventions, such as cognitive behavioral therapy (CBT) and guided self-help, in groups or one-to-one meetings.

We also support schools and colleges with whole-school approaches to mental health and wellbeing, for example, by providing advice and training to staff on wellbeing issues. This helps us to support children by forming a link between the school and other support services.

Trainee EMHPs undergo a 12-month training program that includes academic teaching and practice to qualify as an EMHP.
