Component 1 – Understanding Drama

Written exam- 1 hour and 45 minutes in May of Y11 40% of GCSE

Assessed on Knowledge and understanding of Drama and theatre, Study of Blood Brothers play and analysis and evaluation of a Theatre makers.

Section A – Multiple choice on Knowledge and understanding of Drama and theatre (4 marks) Section B - A mix of 4 short and long answer questions on Blood Brothers (44 marks) Section C- One long answer question on theatre makers based on a live theatre production (32 marks) Component 2 – Devising Drama Practical exam and development log.

October – December of Y11. 40% of GCSE

Devise, rehearse, perform and analyse/ evaluate own piece if theatre in small groups (each candidate individually assessed – not a whole group mark)
